Exploring positions

"How to select a university ..., which is right for me!?"

Think carefully about what you enjoy

- For me, being a teacher-scholar
- Enjoy one-on-one interactions with students
- Particularly, those who don't see CS as a default choice
- Think of myself as a scholar
- Immersive for my teacher and scholarly persona
- Research/Scholarship: "Quality not quantity..."
- Careful, reflective, continuously improve teaching

ob Search 2015 (Darakhshan Mir)

Applied selectively, decided to go on the market because of two-body lingering issues from grad school

Was more discriminating this time around

"Is it possible to move from a non-tenure to a tenured job at the same school, or should I start applying to other schools."
